**SUGAR NOW CHEAPER TO RETAILER,
SAYS SALES MANAGER OF FEDERAL**

Maintaining that the reduced tariff rate has lowered the cost of sugar, the retailer at least, F. C. Lowrey, manager of the sales department of the Federal Sugar Refining Company, has issued the following statement from his New York office:

In view of the irresponsible statements that have been made, I judge that you will be interested in learning the extent to which the price of sugar has been reduced because of the reduction in the tariff of 34 cents per hundred pounds.
