Two Great Railroad Bridges. Seven spans varying in estimated cost from \$800,000 to \$35,000,000 have been proposed for the longer bridge from Dawes point to Milson point in Sydney harbor, New South Wales, and one at an estimated cost of about \$13,750,000 has been adopted. It provides for a structure 2600 feet long between centers of anchorage piers and includes two 500-foot anchor spans, two 520-foot cantilever arms and a 550-foot center span.
