

Role Played by Heredity

The current emphasis on the role played by heredity in determining the make-up and functioning of the normal person has again brought into prominence the idea of constitutional defects as important factors in various manifestations of disease. Dr. Amos W. Peters of the Training School at Vineland, N. J., has contended that feeble-mindedness should be regarded as a constitutional anomaly of the individual, which he has either inherited or acquired. As he points out, according to this theory, feeble-mindedness is not an isolated psychologic or even an isolated brain phenomenon, but is constitutional, general and far-reaching throughout brain and body. The importance of this view lies primarily in the fact that it points to the necessity of investigating the problems of the feeble-minded in directions additional to the customary psychologic, psychiatric or anatomic paths of scientific inquiry. So far as the broader sociologic aspects of the situation are concerned, one of the chief considerations undoubtedly is the prevention of the increase in the number of the feeble-minded.
