MEXICANS ARREST AND HUMILIATE U. S. NAVY MEN CITY OF MEXICO.

Although they wore the uniform of the United States navy, were unarmed and entered the city with an unfurled American flag, an officer and a detachment of marines from a United States warship lying in Tampico harbor were arrested in that city yesterday when they landed, were paraded through the streets under order of the arresting officer and held under detention for some time. When the news of the arrest and detention reached Admiral Mayo he made vigorous protestations against the procedure and the Americans were released. President Huerta, when apprised of the incident, apologized to Admiral Mayo and made a promise to investigate the circumstances and punish the parties responsible.

CONDEMNED MEN MAY GET NEW TRIALS

NEW YORK. — Supreme Justice John Goff signed an order yesterday making it mandatory upon the district attorney to show cause why the four gun men convicted of murder in connection with the killing of Moritz Rosenthal, the gambler, should not be granted a new trial. The order was made returnable today and was filed on the grounds presented by attorneys of the convicted gunners that new evidence had been discovered.
