BRITISH SUBJECTS WON'T SEND CHILDREN TO SCHOOL

NEW YORK. — Arthur Evans was fined \$10 in court in Newark, N. J., about two months ago for not sending his daughter to school, in default of which he went to jail. He was summoned to appear before Judge Hahn for the same offense recently but failed to appear and the judge issued a bench warrant. He will be arrested again. Evans contends he is not compelled to send his daughter to school because he is a British subject.

Robert Hobbler was also haled to court because he declined to send his son to school. He is a West Indian and a British subject. He told Judge Hahn he feared his son would have to swear allegiance to the Stars and Stripes, and when informed that his belief was erroneous he said his son had no decent clothes.

Judge Hahn promised that the board of education officials would provide clothing, but Hobbler will not accept any charity. He was given a week to send his boy to school or be punished.
