BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of Honolulu, Territory of Hawaii, that the portion of Nuuanu Valley, District of Honolulu, lying on the Southeast side of Nuuanu Avenue between Laimi and Puiwa Streets, and more particularly described by arithm and distance in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and made a part hereof is hereby declared to constitute an Improvement District to be known as Nuuanu Improvement District No. 3.
