

**GREAT GUSHER**

**STILL SPOUTS HEAVY YIELD**

According to the following from the Chronicle of June 8, the Lakeview No. 2 gusher continued to spout at that date and the interesting fact is stated that the well is on patented land so that the product is not subject to the outcome of the pending government suits regarding oil lands.

The great gusher of the Lakeview No. 2 Oil Company, in the Maricopa district continues to spout between 50,000 and 40,000 barrels of oil a day, according to the estimates of expert oil men, who have been keeping a close watch on the big well since it came in. The flow has shown no diminution to speak of since it was brought in and the management of the company is finding the task of caring for the enormous output a difficult one. By leasing storage space from other companies and building new pumps and reservoirs the management is doing as well as could be expected under the circumstances although the percentage of the output, containing emulsion, is causing no little trouble. The oil, which is mixed with sediment, has to be run to storage and held there until the clarifying plants in course of construction are completed.

The company is marketing about 15,000 barrels a day from the well, and a good portion of this amount is secured by skimming the slumps and thereby getting the lighter product, which is almost free from emulsion. The pipe lines running from the well continued to be taxed to capacity in caring for the production.

An important item in connection with this well, and one which has not been given much publicity, is that it was brought in on patented land, and the Lakeview No. 2 Company is not hampered by the possibility of a clash with the government in marketing its product. Several gushers have been completed recently in the Maricopa district, and the production of most of them are tied up with government suits, because the wells were developed on lands in dispute under withdrawal order.
