SUPERVISOR OSORIO GIVEN LESSON IN ART OF POLITICS
(Special Star-Bulletin Correspondence)
HILO, July 10.—By some neat parliamentary strategy Supervisor Osorio's resolution requiring Tax Assessor R. T. Forrest to turn his automobile back to the county was lost in the shuffle the last day of the board's session. When the resolution was presented some one moved that owing to other pressing business before the board the measure be deferred. It was an innocent appearing motion, to a novice, and Osorio let it go at that, expecting to bring it up later.
But when he did make the effort to resurrect the resolution, just before the board adjourned Tuesday, Chairman David Ewald refused to recognize him, declaring him out of order. Supervisor Julian Yates then firmly but gently broke the news to Osorio that his resolution was a dead letter, the motion to defer carrying no clause fixing its reconsideration for a definite future date. To defer this, declared Yates, was equivalent to indefinite postponement. The majority of the board appeared to be opposed to the proposition anyhow, so it probably would have been useless to call a vote on the subject, except to place the various members on record in the matter.

P. C. JONES FOR THE PAST 40 YEARS HAS SERVED OAHU COLLEGE
P. C. Jones' connection with Oahu college commenced July 14, 1874, his term of service with that organization numbering 40 years tomorrow.
In honor of this long and faithful service fitting observances will be held, prior to Mr. Jones taking his departure on a long delayed visit to the mainland.
Mr. Jones recently resigned as member of the board of trustees of the college. The resignation becomes effective tomorrow.
VON WOELLWORTH IS REMEMBERED IN NORTH
Portland persons who knew "Baron Von Woellworth" when the purported scion of nobility was in Portland, received word from Honolulu that he left the island city under circumstances somewhat similar to those under which he left Portland, says The Oregonian.
The "Baron," who was the framer of a gigantic riding school scheme in Portland, which died unborn because of lack of funds, started a similar scheme in Honolulu and after charges of gross cheating had been filed against him, is said to have left Honolulu in the steerage of the steamer Sierra about two weeks ago. The money for the passage, it is said, was furnished the "Baron" by a prominent church worker.
Following his leaving Portland, "Baron" Von Woellworth went to Honolulu where he worked for three months grubbing stumps on the plantation of S. Lucas, at Tantalus. His efforts to finance his "riding academy" are said to have led to the charges against him. False checks are said to have caused the charges.
On his arrest, his bail was first set at \$2000, but gradually reduced to \$250, which he could not supply. He was allowed his freedom on his own recognition, and is said to have then taken the boat.
