Morning on CHANGE

Olaa cascaded again today to the volume of 1075 shares in sales between boards and at the session, opening with a decline of 1-8 point, making an advance of 3-8 and closing at 1-4 point better than Saturday's quotation. At 2 flat 225 shares were sold, followed by 200 at 2.25, 275 at 2.50 and 375 at 2.37 1/2. Hawaiian Sugar gained 1-2 point in a reported sale of 40 shares at 27.50 and advanced 1-8 point for 5 shares on the board. Ewa was steady at 18.25 for 175 shares between boards. Oahu Sugar opened at an advance of 1-4 for 100 shares reported, gained another quarter for two lots of 10 shares each on the board and fell back an equal degree to 14.50 for 10 shares, making a net gain of 1-4. Onomea opened at a decline of 1-4 for 40 and 10 shares in recess; recovering the loss in a sale of 5 shares on the board on the board at 20.75. Hawaiian Commercial opened at session with a gain of 5-8 in sales of 75 shares in three lots at 27.37 1/2, receding 1-8 for 5 5 shares. Wai'alua retained 65 for 5 shares, and McBryde 3.50 for 15 and 10 shares.

To abolish the "plucking board" of the navy, Representative Britten of Honolulu, introduced a bill proposing retirement by a system of mental and physical examination for promotion to each grade.

The three-masted schooner Jennie A. Pickles of Annapolis, N. S., went ashore in Bay of Fundy during a thick fog and at half tide her decks were washed and it was believed she would be a total loss. The crew reached shore.
