Fort Shafter Notes

[Special Star-Bulletin Correspondence.]

FORT SHAFTER, August 3.—The usual monthly change in non-commissioned officers for the duty of provost guard in Honolulu took place on the 1st of August. The new detail will be in charge of Sergeant Fred H. Young, Company M, 2nd Infantry. The remainder of the detail is as follows: Corpl. Cecil A. Lentz, Co. A; Frank Bradley, Co. B; Corpl. Otto C. Buegge, Co. C; Sergt. F. Smith, Co. D; Sergt. Chester C. Barth, Co. E; Corpl. Vernah E. Loftan, Co. I; Corpl. Ray Mills, Co. K; Sergt. Abraham Liftman, Co. L.

A change in the date for the 2nd battalion to take the field has been announced and that command will leave for Waimanalo on the 7th instead of on the 10th as originally contemplated. The battalion will be absent from the post about two weeks. In order that the recruits may accompany the companies of the command they will be turned in for duty with their respective organizations on Thursday of this week and the same will apply to the new men of the 1st battalion; and all officers and non-commissioned officers on duty with the recruits will be relieved from that duty on that date. As usual the Signal Corps will make special provision for maintaining communication with troops absent from the garrison and Major Lenihan's battalion will be connected with the post through their efforts. In the present case the Signal Corps will send out with the command one of their wireless pack sections and that detachment of Captain Gibbs' company will open up with the main station of the company at Fort Shafter and the communication once established will be maintained throughout the continuance of the tour of the infantry battalion at Waimanalo. This arrangement is in line with Captain Gibbs' record as an officer always ready to seize any opportunity to further the work of the line and at the same time give the men of his company practice in their own specialty of field communication.

SUGAR OUTPUT OF CUBA IN 1914.

The sugar crop of Cuba for the season of 1914 will, by allowing conservative further production to mills still grinding, reach at least the total of 2,575,000 tons. If the weather remains of a normal character for the remainder of the rainy season, the production will in all probability go still higher, and may surpass 2,600,000 tons, which will represent a gain of about 175,000 tons over the great crop of the year preceding.
