SHU SHIN IS FOUND GUILTY OF MURDER IN THE SECOND DEGREE

After deliberating an hour a jury in Circuit Judge Ashford's court yesterday afternoon found Shu Shin, a Chinese, guilty of manslaughter in the second degree for the killing of a countryman on the evening of September 18. Shu Shin was indicted for first-degree murder. He was given a sentence of 5 years' imprisonment, with costs remitted.
