How the Career of the German Cruiser Emden Ended

CHINESE SEEK U. S. HARBOR NOTES

BACKERS FOR SHIP LINE. The next mail from the mainland is due Friday in the Pacific Mail liner Mongolia.

To make a comprehensive study of trade conditions with a view of establishing a steamship line between the Orient and the west coast of the United States, a delegation of Chinese businessmen from North and South China are expected to pass through Honolulu the middle of April.

Advices brought by the Pacific Mail liner Korea indicate the Chinese will remain in San Francisco a week, visit all the principal Coast cities, and then make a tour of the country, lasting 70 days.

While on the Pacific coast the Chinese will be entertained by the trade bodies that constitute the Association of Chambers of Commerce of the Pacific Coast.

The visit of these Chinese merchants is the result of a tour of China made in 1910 by a party of Pacific coast merchants and manufacturers.

German Steamers Being Refloated. The work of refloating the three sunken German vessels, the Ellen Rickmers, the Durendart and the M. J. J. Jensen at the entrance to the main harbor of Talingtau is going on in full blast.

Due at Honolulu about Sunday, the Canadian-Australasian liner Niagara has steamed from Suva. It will bring several hundred tons of general cargo and refrigerated provisions for delivery at Honolulu.

Taking freight and passengers, the steamer Kilauea has been substituted for the Mauna Loa on the next trip to Kona and Kau ports.

Taking 650 tons of bunker coal, the new British freighter City of Newcastle, steamed for Vladivostok last evening.

Returning from Kauai today the steamer W. G. Hall has discharged 3032 sacks of Lihue and 1969 sacks of Grove Farm sugar.

According to Capt. Abram of the British tramp steamer City of Newcastle, at least a half dozen vessels belonging to the Ellerman line will pass through Honolulu en route to the Far East within the next two months.

Idle Two Years, Iwalani Steams.

Out of commission for more than two years, the Inter-Island steamer Iwalani has been pressed into service to assist in the movement of an accumulation of sugar at Kauai and Maui ports.

The Iwalani returned from Kauai yesterday bringing 4300 sacks of sugar and a quantity of sundries.
