#### AUSTRALIA HOPES TO FURNISH MOLYBDENUM

[Associated Press] SYDNEY, Australia.—A plant for treating molybdenite ores has been established here, and a first shipment of 190 tons of metal is to be sent to England in June.

The principal supplies of molybdenum have heretofore come from German sources, and the cutting off of these supplies has caused considerable embarrassment in England. The metal is used in the manufacture of special steels, having the quality of increasing greatly the tensile strength of steel when added to it.
