WRECK OF CHIYO MARU MAY MEAN TOUR CANCELLED
Guests of Two Big Pasadena Hotels Were to Have Called Here Both Ways

Plans for the Oriental tour de luxe
of the Maryland-Huntington hotels of
Pasadena, California, including visits
to Honolulu going and returning, have
been set askew by the loss of the pa-
latial T. K. K. liner Chiyo Maru, now
a total wreck on the Lema islands,
south of Hongkong.

It is possible that the party may
leave on the T. K. K. South American
liner Kiyu Maru, due to steam from
San Francisco May 18. The Chiyo
was due to leave at port May 13,
with the big hotel party, arriving in
Honolulu May 19, but now that she is
pounded to pieces on the Lema rocks
the tour may have to be abandoned.

The original plans, according to the
Pasadena Star-News of March 28,
were for the tour to start Friday, May
12, from Pasadena. The complete ite-
rinary was arranged late in March
and published in booklet form. "This
tour is for guests of the two hotels,"
says the Pasadena paper, "and Pa-
sadenans generally, and is planned un-
der the personal direction of Manager
D. M. Linnard. It will include visits
to the Hawaiian islands, Japan, the
Philippines and China.

"The start from Pasadena will be
on Friday, May 12. The following day
the party will leave San Francisco on
the triple screw steamship Chiyo
Maru, 22,000 tons. The first port of
call will be Honolulu, on Friday, May
19. Twelve hours will be spent here,
and there will be motor car excursions
to points of interest. On the return
trip several days will be spent in
the Hawaiian Islands."

Prince August William, fourth son
of the Kaiser, will go to Brussels to
serve as assistant to Governor-General
von Bisping of Belgium.

Striking longshoremen of the East-
ern Steamship Corporation of New
York returned to work, having been
granted increased wages.
