**"MRS. MARY GOODE" DEAD IN NEW YORK**

NEW YORK, N. Y.—"Mrs. Mary Goode," whose revelations of police graft were one of the most startling features of the investigation of police methods following the Rosenthal murder, is dead, and her death has disclosed that she devoted the last four years of her life to the uplifting of fallen women. Once she kept a respectable house and according to her testimony paid certain policemen \$50 a month for protection. Since her reformation, it is said, she spent most of an allowance of \$8000 a year received from her family in her rescue work.

She always refused to tell her real name, but it is said she came of a reputable upstate family. She died of pneumonia contracted after a visit to the women's night court in the rain.
