HILL LINE SHIPS MAY RUN DOWN TO SAN PEDRO SOON

The two big turbiners, Great Northern and North Pacific, will soon be put on a new schedule along the coast, according to tentative plans of the steamship company, with the probability that they will run between Flavel, San Francisco and San Pedro. This new service, it is understood, will go into effect after the Great Northern returns from her present voyage to Honolulu, which completes the winter service to Hawaii, says the San Francisco Chronicle.

REFINERS SEEK TO ACCUMULATE LARGER SUPPLY

NEW YORK, N. Y., April 23.—When the market reopened on Monday morning following the Easter holidays new conditions presented themselves, inasmuch as on Friday, April 6, Congress had declared war on Germany. The good demand for refined sugar noted in our last review appeared again in increased volume, as the reality of war made the domestic trader more anxious than ever to accumulate a stock of sugar greatly in excess of present needs. The cancellation of many freight contracts by various steamship companies engaged in the Cuban, Porto Rico and San Domingo sugar trade, and the consequent uncertainty regarding the tonnage situation, greatly restricted offerings of raws.

LISTED SHARES ARE IN DEMAND

Despite receipt of a lower quotation on sugar the local stock market took on a volume of business today that was fully double that of recent days. It is possible that buyers seek some clarifying of the shipping problem and this was about the only reason offered for the sudden increase in business. It was not a selling movement in any way and fractional advances were scored in several instances, San Carlos being the strongest sugar stock.

The Star-Bulletin wishes to announce the receipt from the Bishop Insurance Agency, Ltd., of the 1917 Fireman's Fund register of vessels documented on the Pacific Coast of the United States and the Hawaiian Islands, issued by the Fireman's Fund Insurance Company.

Copies of the new register arrived at the local agency a few days ago, and are of much value to shipping men of this port, owing to the many changes in ownership of Pacific Coast vessels since the last register was printed.

Vessels of the Inter-Island and Oahu Shipping Company's fleets are included in the new register. The Hamakua (formerly Shoshone) is included after the 1916 register was printed.
