# **WAKE UP, VOTERS!**

The Automobile Club's bill providing a specific tax on real and personal property within the City and County of Honolulu passed the 1917 Legislature and was signed by the Governor.

This will give \$300,000 a year for permanent road construction.

\$150,000 a year for water and sewer reconstruction and improvement to keep pace with the roads.

\$ 50,000 a year for free sewer and pumping of cesspools.

## **And In Addition**

There will be \$500,000 available from loan funds for reconstruction of the Belt Road from the Pali toward Koalaupia.

Also, upwards of \$200,000 available from the general improvement fund of the county.

Thus making ample provision for carrying out the comprehensive plan placed before the Legislature and community by the Automobile Club officers cooperating with the Board of Supervisors, the Ad Club, the Board of Retail Trade and the Chamber of Commerce Legislative Committee.

## **Who is to Spend This Money?**
