TELEGRAPHIC ITEMS

Kruger denounces the use of blacks by the British.

President Hays of the Southern Pacific has resigned.

American are in control of the London meat market.

A national reciprocity convention will be held at Philadelphia.

Columbia University will have a chair of Chinese languages.

China seeks a definite understanding with Russia about Manchuria.

Satisfactory conditions are reported from the Northern Philippines.

Chili will not be represented at the Pan-American Congress at the City of Mexico.

The last of the bars of gold taken from the Selby smelter have been recovered.

Friendly personal relations are probable between King Edward and the Czar.

The re-enactment of the Chinese exclusion law is opposed by Eastern manufacturers.

A new steamship company is being exploited to cross the Atlantic in less than five days.

The Czar is said to have offended the British by inviting Krueger to attend his sister's wedding.

Russia is building fortifications at Newchang, and pushing the railroad to the Korean frontier.

There is a break in the ranks of the steel men at Chicago, and a dozen have joined the strikers.

John Winters the Selby Smelting Works robber, has been sentenced to fifteen years imprisonment.

As soon as the Iowa is ready she will be sent to Panama. The Ranger is under the same orders.

The Cunard liner Lucania was reported by wireless telegraph while still 300 miles from New York.

A plague of caterpillars is stripping the shade trees of the White House grounds at Washington.

Three British gunboats have sailed for the Brazilian coast, to be ready in case of trouble at Rio de Janeiro.

Experiments with mosquito infection of yellow fever will be discontinued, as one patient has died at Havana.

Fights over claims at Cape Nome have resulted in the calling out of United States troops to guard claims.

Harriman is planning a tunnel for the Sierras. It will five miles in length, and among the longest in the world.

A body of 400 Kurds have destroyed twelve villages in Armenia, killing all the males and carrying off the young girls.

The States Department has invited all nations to be represented at the Louisiana Purchase Exposition at St. Louis in 1903.

Unless the decrees of punishment for the authors of the Chuchau massacres are carried out immediately, British troops will remain in China.

A Boer agent has sued the British Consul at New Orleans for slander in connection with the story of an attempt to blow up a British transport there.

Gerhardt Terlinger, a German, after a long pursuit, was arrested at Milwaukee for having embezzled 1,500,000 marks from the German Government.

The French Ambassador, M. Constant, has notified the Sultan's first secretary that all diplomatic relations between France and Turkey are broken off.

The Signal Corps of the War Department has been conducting experiments along original lines with wireless telegraphy for three years and has developed a system that will soon be put into practical operation upon the Pacific coast for signaling arriving transports.
