TELEGRAPHIC ITEMS

Berkeley defeated Stanford at
outball, with a score of 16 to 0.

President Roosevelt is on a two-
weeks' trip in the west and south.

Eggs range in price from 40 to 65
cents per dozen in San Francisco.

The president will largely discuss
trusts in his forthcoming message to
congress.

New York city is still suffering a
coal famine, with no immediate pros-
pect of relief.

A heavy bear movement in the
New York stock market is causing
fears of a panic.

Premier Sagasta has tendered to
King Alfonso the resignation of the
entire Spanish cabinet.

The crown prince of Siam is en-
gaged to marry the eldest daughter
of the emperor of Japan.

Dr. Charlton claims to have dis-
covered a serum which will success-
fully combat scarlet fever.

Emperor Nicholas of Russia is
suffering from a severe attack of
depression and melancholia.

It is rumored that Mark Hanna
will retire from public life when his
present term in the senate expires.

Miss Stone, the missionary wishes
to return to Macedonia, but the
Turkish authorities will not permit
it.

Marconi is preparing to establish
a wireless system of telegraphy be-
tween the Coast and the Hawaiian
Islands.

Millionaire Ed. Butler of St. Louis
was found guilty of bribery, and sen-
tenced to three years in the peni-
tentiary.

Secretary Shaw of the U. S.
Treasury has declined to render
any further aid to the New York
financiers.

Belle Lawson, a beautiful sixteen
year old white girl of Oklahoma elop-
ed with Panther, a full-blooded Osage
Indian chief.

Emperor William's visit to King
Edward is supposed to have refer-
ence to possible continued occupa-
tion of Shanghai.

Six craters have broken out and
are emitting smoke and flames in
Savaii, the largest island of the
Samoan group.

An attempt was made to assassi-
nate King Leopold of Belgium by an
Italian anarchist, who fired three
shots at the king.

Judge Morrow of the United States
Circuit Court hold the salt trust an
illegal body, which ruling will prob-
ably dissolve the trust.

A serious fire has greatly damag-
ed the new East River bridge in New
York city, which will delay its com-
pletion for a year or more.

A company of militia at Mobile,
Alabama, were called out to prevent
the lynching of Louis Wyatt, a
negro, for attacking a six-year old
girl.

An authorized translation of Pres-
ident Roosevelt's book, "A Strenu-
ous Life," into French has been made,
bearing the title of "La Via In-
tense."

Forty-seven prisoners escaped
from an Arizona jail, fatally wound-
ing one of the jailors, and are mak-
ing their way across the Mexican
border.

Through the influence of Booker T.
Washington, two Alabama anti-negro
republicans have been removed from
office, and their places filled by dem-
ocrats.

Secretary Root has confirmed the
charges that a Catholic priest met
his death in the Philippines at the
hands of volunteers who subjected
him to the "water-cure."

A panic existed at Melbourne, No-
vember 15, caused by extraordinary
clouds of red dust which enshrouded
the city, accompanied by balls of fire
which fell and set fire to several
buildings.
