The petition signed by some of the citizens of the County of Maui to have W. J. Coelho run as Senator for the County of Maui, contains a strange mixture of names; so say those who saw it before the day of the Republican Convention held on the 28th day of October last, the day Coelho hoped to be nominated by the Republican Party as Senator. There were a few Republican names on the petition; a large number of Democratic and Home Rule names.

These people are not desirable people to become citizens for Hawaii, but the Plantations would be forced to import them if they could not get laborers from European countries, that is, Portuguese. The Portuguese are industrious and make good citizens and are the best immigrants we can import, but Link McCandless wants them shut out.

#### More Evidence of Prosperity.
