### There May Be a Race.

Word comes from Honolulu that Louis Warren is willing to accept O'Rourke's challenge for match races between their respective horses. The challenge having been sent, and accepted, it now looks as though there was nothing left but to arrange details.

Warren is willing, in fact accepts Hilo John's propositions, provided the races are run in Honolulu and he will pay the expenses necessary to bring the Hilo horses to Honolulu.

Challenge No. 1, accepted by Warren, is to run his racer Oucata against O'Rourke's Sonoma a half or five-eighths of a mile for five hundred or a thousand a side.

Challenge No. 2, which Warren also accepts, is to run his horse Umuqua against O'Rourke's Major Collier for a half a mile for five hundred.

The races shall be run on the Kapiolani Park track and Warren and those back of him will pay John's expenses in bringing down his animals.

Labor Day, the first coming holiday, which falls this year on Monday, September 2, is the day set for the races, if O'Rourke wants to meet Warren half way on the proposition.

In addition to the two races above mentioned, provided the parties to these will come together, there will be a large number of other interesting races as the following tentative list will go a long way to show:

Pacing race, mile heats, best three out of five, between Maui, the Valley Isle champion harness horse; Chappo, Harold D., Sid Abbott and Walter P. Such a race, even were it the only number on the

program, would draw thousands to Kapiolani Park.

Half-mile running race between Lizzie Moore, Clara C., Racine Murphy and Lovedale, the latter a recent "dark horse" importation from the Coast, now at Ewa, the property of Caesar Gomes.

Three-eighths mile running race between Medeiros' Dora D., the fine little mare which won handily her two races on the Fourth; Frankie, Dixie, Buckskin and Palama.
