WASHINGTON, May 26—Council of defense is seriously considering the importation of Chinese laborers to relieve situation. Colossal task before red cross told at conference of leading women of forty cities by Hoover, Taft, and Baker. President Wilson will proclaim June 18 to 25 Red Cross Week to solicit funds.

Treasury department has discovered Japanese have been steadily withdrawing gold at the rate of \$1,520,000,000 a year and increasing now at the rate of \$15,000,000 per week, with knowledge Japanese government. McAdoo says is economic more than political but is very disconcerting.

HONOLULU, May 25—Harry Irwin appointed first district magistrate to succeed Monsarrat.

Anthrax appears on Oahu. Twelve cows in herd of Corn dairy died and more are dying. Board of Agriculture called hurried meeting and imposed strict quarantine, and will take every precaution. Embargo on cattle shipments from Oahu to other islands imposed. Shot gun quarantine against all dogs on or entering premises, will be killed.

Rizenburg, of first field artillery court martialled. Asleep on guard. Sentenced to dismissal from service, six months hard labor, and to forfeit two-third of pay for an additional six months.

LONDON, May 25—Lloyd Georg announces that allies are breaking down submarine menace and that food situation is improving daily. Necessity for economy still remains. Owe considerable debt for assistance of American navy.

PARIS, May 25—Part of Chevreux woods captured by the French. German trenches and shelters found filled with dead killed by artillery fire.

RIO DE JANEIRO, May 25—Commission decides to renounce neutrality and to police Atlantic with Brazil's fleets.

WASHINGTON, May 25—Trading with the enemy bill introduced in house by Adams. Modeled on same lines as British.

ROME, May 25—Battle raging from Adriatic to Plaza. 10,245 Austrian prisoners taken.

TOPEKA, May 25—Two tornadoes, one half mile apart swept between Peabody and Florence. Reported several killed.


