CLAIMS AGAINST THE UNITED STATES

KINLEY MCGOWAN, Esq., Register of the U. S. Navy, and CHARLES J. SHELDEN, Comptroller of the U. S. Navy, will receive applications and statements of demands against the United States, growing out of the present war, including the accounts and claims of State, Comptroller, and other officers of the Navy, and the restoration of property illegally seized or captured, and recompence for the use of vessels required for Governmental purposes, and for damages in the property of such persons by the military pay bureaus, and bounty lands, and for deductible shares of monies paid at the Treasury for the same.

They will also give rights to the claimants, to make, and to use, "national agents in ultimate disposal," to represent their demands.

With the same spirit of justice, they will then, as equitable as possible, of all claims will be made.

Official Demands will be collected and promptly remitted for a compensation of from a half cent, and a half per cent—depending on the amount, and negotiations with the Department.

By prior arrangement, moderate charges, only, will be made, and a minute knowledge of the law, and of the business of the department, they hope to render their services useful to claimants and their friends.

The same may be made to Members of Congress, and officers of the Government, and especially to the Hon. ALONZO WOODWARD, Postmaster-General, and the Hon. JAMES J. COOPER, Secretary of the Treasury.
