MADRID, June 26.—Queen Mercedes died this morning. Queen Mercedes, it will be remembered, was married to the young King of Spain on January 23 of the present year.

Through much together from their earliest childhood, Alfonso and Queen Mercedes became tenderly attached to each other, and the young Alfonso used to address his fair cousin as "My little wife."

The young Queen was born in Madrid on the 24th of June, 1859. She was considered very beautiful. She was of Spanish type, with very black hair and eyes, fine features and full figure.

Before the death of the Queen the King and members of the royal family were assembled around the Queen's bed. The ministers were summoned to the palace early this morning, and in the foreign office all the chiefs of the diplomatic corps were assembled.
