From Pioneer District.

PICKET POST, PIONEER DISTRICT. PINAL COUNTY, June 28, 1878.

EDITOR CITIZEN:—Having a few days spare time, I concluded to visit a few of the mines in this district and satisfy myself as to the reported rich strikes in the Eureka and other claims on what is called the Silver Belle belt.

The first mine visited was the Eureka, which is owned by Messrs. Wheeler and Whitlow, on examination I found the shaft to be eighteen feet deep and eight feet wide, at the bottom of the shaft the vein is thirty inches wide and will average twenty-two inches from top to bottom.

The next mine I came to was the Goodenough, owned by Messrs. Stone, Wolven and Culver, neither of whom were at home, consequently I did not have a chance to examine the shaft, but found several tons of very fine ore on the dump.

On arrival at the Picket Post my ears were greeted with a thundering long whistle from the '76 mill. The Superintendent of the '76, Mr. S. W. Foreman, invited the ladies and gentlemen in the vicinity to be present and witness the starting of the mill.

Peace Considered Assured.
