MINES OF ARIZONA.

From Mr. Ike Bradshaw, an old experienced miner who came to Arizona, in company with his brother, after whom the famous Bradshaw Mountain was named, and John Tatum, the man who never "gits," in the Summer of 1853, we have elicited the following reliable information regarding our mining prospects and future outlook.

The King, in Pinal county, owned by Barney & Ruggin, is down 150 feet, and a large mass of ore, the same as that found on the surface, continues to exist, which averages good and bad, \$800 to the ton.
