MAKES HOUSECLEANING EASY

Mop Attachment That Will Be Appreciated by Those Who Have to Do the Work.

An improved type of house cleaner has been invented by a Pennsylvania man. It is a mop with an attachment by which it can be wrung dry by the turning of a crank and a device which holds it spread out on the floor. There is a long handle, of course, with a metal holder at the bottom. The cloth is removably attached to this

holder by wires and the lower part of the holder is so hinged that it follows the movement of the mop. Thus, when the cleaner is swabbed over the floor, this section of the apparatus holds it flat and permits it to be used with much more effectiveness than when it is necessary to poke it about in a lump. The upper end of the cloth is attached to a beveled gear, which is operated by a crank. When the mop is to be wrung out, the crank is turned and the gear twists the cloth tightly. A thumb screw lock on the crank shaft prevents the crank from turning at other times. This cleaner is useful not only on floors but on ceilings, walls and windows.

The Home



In preparing egg plant press it under water instead of just salting, as is customary. This prevents the vegetable from turning black and keeps it much crispier.

Tomatoes cannot be cooked in a hurry. If you cannot give them at least an hour, preferably two, do without them for that time. They will taste raw and offend the palate of one who knows how they should taste.

Never use sandsoap on a porcelain-lined tub or washstand. There is no surer way to ruin the enamel. What's the use of soap? It means only extra work, and there is always the coal oil rag, which is better.

Lamp chimneys can be quickly cleaned by holding the hand over one end and putting the other end over the spout of a simmering tea kettle. Rub at once with a smooth cloth or tissue paper.

In making a boiled icing the secret of success lies in taking off exactly at the right moment. A better test than spinning a heavy thread is to drop some of the syrup into cold water, and when it adheres to bottom of glass when pulled up it must be taken off at once.

Pineapple Pudding.
One cupful of tapioca, four teaspoonfuls of water, one teaspoonful of sugar, one small juicy pineapple. Soak the tapioca over night in one and one-half cupfuls of water, add two and one-half cupfuls more of water and cook in a double boiler until transparent. Add the sugar and finely minced pineapple. Put into a wet mold and chill. Serve plain or whipped cream. Delicious.

Use for Creamed Entrees.
Handsome china ramekins should not be used as baking dishes, but reserved for creamed entrees. To put in the oven have a set of the most attractive individual earthenware dishes you can find. Many of these now come with silver cases for table use.

Molasses Cookies.
Two cups molasses, 1 cup shortening, 1/2 cup sour milk, 4 even teaspoonfuls soda, 1 teaspoonful ginger. Stir in as much flour as possible, stand in a cool place 20 minutes, roll dough out quite thin and bake in a hot oven.

Making Candles.
By keeping candle molds at hand, a few candles may be made at a time as the suet accumulates, and the ends of candles, and the droppings on the candlesticks, may be melted and run into fresh candles.
