


SWIMMING BATHS.

SALMON OF THE SACRAMENTO.

Are They the Property of the Cannermen or of the People?

The Former Vigorously Opposing Legislation in the Interests of the General Public.

There seems to be an irrepressible conflict going on between the organized destroyers of the fish and game of the State and a few champions of the interests of the people, men who realize the importance of preserving for future generations some portion of the blessing that is enjoyed by those now living.

The men who operate the fish canneries and their co-workers who traffic in the hides of the deer of the mountains, are always found arrayed in opposition to the interests of the public, and too often their nefarious schemes to rob the latter have been permitted to succeed.

Just now, while an effort is being made, through the medium of the Legislature, to so amend the laws as to afford some protection to the salmon of the Sacramento River against the rapacity of those who would exterminate these choice food fishes in a few years, the canneries, they are found contesting that effort with a determination that is full of danger to the people.

The "interests" of the companies--as the latter choose to regard the matter--and those of the public, are diametrically opposed to one another. The canneries want to have the closed season for salmon, as it has been for some years past, confined to the month of September, to which it was changed in 1888 through their influence, while the interests of the people demand that the old law shall be restored.

Woodbury, Superintendent of the State Fish Hatcheries, said: "The canneries claim that by closing the season at the end of August, the fishermen and others are thrown out of work. But if they are to have their own way, it will only be a short time when they will have no work at all. The salmon will be depleted." He was willing to accede to the canneries and fishermen the month of September, but he would insist upon August being the closed season. He also wanted the month of April included.

What Experience Has Stown. "Ten years ago, during the administration of B. B. Redding, S. R. Throckmorton and J. D. Farwell as Fish Commissioners, as many as 1,000,000 salmon eggs were taken during the month of September from the fall run of salmon. The closed season at that time was during the month of August. The closed season is now, and has been for some years since, during the month of September. The Government hatchery on the McCloud River renewed its operations in 1888, when the number of eggs taken in September, 1888, was only about 1,500,000, and in 1889, only about 1,000,000, and in 1890, only about 500,000, and in 1891, only about 200,000. This is a loss of ninety per cent.

It is of the utmost importance that the closed season should be placed back again to the month of August, so that the salmon do not reach the McCloud River during the month of September than have died there during the past two years, serious consequences will happen to the salmon industry of California.

Some More Testimony. Superintendent George B. Williams, of the McCloud River hatchery, in a recent letter on this subject, declared that "unless some action is taken by the Legislature and those interested in the propagation of salmon as a food fish, to include the month of August as well as that of September in the closed season, not many years will elapse when this valuable food fish will become almost extinct."

In a Nutshell. The whole matter resolves itself into these questions: Shall the Legislature legislate in the interests of the canneries, or shall it be governed in its action by a desire to subserve the interests of the people at large? Shall the salmon be exterminated in a few years,
