

FRUIT FOR THE EAST.

The First Carload of Cherries Passes Through Sacramento.

The Prospects Are Bright for a Great Year—Eastern Buyers Are Here.

The first car-load of cherries for the Eastern markets passed through this city for the East last night. The fruit was from Yacaville.

Now that the "ball is open," so to speak, fruit specials bound over the Sierra Nevada will be quite common for many months to come.

THIS YEAR AND LAST. In summing up the work of the Fruit Union in shipping fruit East, the San Francisco Bulletin, in last evening's issue, says: "Last year the Fruit Union's shipping season began May 21st, and in 1889 on May 18th."

Manager L. W. Buck of the Fruit Union, who is also a member of the State Board of Horticulture, says that every prospect horticulturally is as promising as could be desired.

Buyers for Eastern firms are now in the fruit districts making contracts with producers. Nat. Salisbury, the right grower of Washington, who is in Chicago, has been at work for some weeks, and other firms have equally energetic buyers.

A press dispatch was received from Yacaville yesterday as follows: "Through the energy of the Earl Fruit Company Yacaville this year has scored the honor of the first full carload of green fruit shipment to the East."

The company's cars have also been collected from other lines and have been taken to the coast.
