LAND HOLDINGS IN SOLANO COUNTY FOR THREE DIFFERENT PERIODS.

The following table shows the 150 largest land-holdings in Solano County for the years 1880, 1885 and 1890. We have, for the purposes of more ready comparison, placed these years side by side in the table.

The table has also been subdivided by footings showing, first, the acreage held in excess of 5,000 acres; second, the acreage held by the fifty largest land-owners; third, the acreage held by the second fifty largest land-owners; fourth, the acreage of the third fifty owners, and in each case the values of such acreage, and the sum total:

Our investigation of the condition and history of the land holdings in the counties of the Sacramento Valley in all the statements heretofore presented show a constant and alarming aggregation of land holdings. In the course of the inquiry we reach Solano County, and as prefatory to the presentation of the facts as relates to that county, we call the reader's careful attention to some recapitulation, that the significance of what has transpired and is transpiring in Solano County may be better understood. We further premise by saying that the aggregation of land holding in Solano County has been arrested and has been at a standstill for ten years. And now as to the result.

There were ten holdings in 1880 of 5,000 acres and upward, aggregating 81,242 acres; in 1885, there were ten, aggregating 87,100 acres; and in 1890, there were nine, aggregating 77,887 acres. Here is a slight decrease, both in the number of the holdings of 5,000 acres and upward and in the aggregate of their holdings. Likewise, the fifty largest holders in 1880 held 205,393 acres; in 1885, they held an aggregate of 208,749; and in 1890, the aggregate of the fifty largest holders was 201,658. This shows a decrease between 1880 and 1890 of 4,000 acres in the aggregate of these holdings. The largest one hundred holders in 1880 held 265,796 acres; in 1885, they held 266,074 acres; and in 1890, they held 262,381 acres. We introduce here the comparative table:

In considering the land-holdings in Butte County, we introduced a new comparative statement by showing the increase of the holdings at the fiftieth and one-hundredth holder. We present in the case of Solano County the following statement, which shows the relative holdings of the twentieth, the fortieth, the sixtieth, the eightieth and the one-hundredth holder in the list of holders:

By this it will be seen that the twenty largest holders in the years 1880, 1885 and 1890 maintained about the same aggregate acreage, and this is equally true entirely down the list of land-holdings. The holdings there having arisen to a certain plane of aggregation, have been moving in a horizontal line upon that plane for ten years.

And now to the consideration of a very significant result: In Colusa County the one hundred largest holders held in 1880 510,224 acres, 541,865 acres in 1885, and 603,010 acres in 1890. There has been an increase in the aggregate holdings of these one hundred holders of 153,000 acres. The population of that county in 1880 was 13,118. The population in 1885 was 14,640, an increase of 1,522. But the natural increase of 13,118 people would be 2,624, on the basis of a net increase of 2 per cent. per annum. Thus the county lost the difference between the gain shown and the natural increase, which is 1,102. Of the increase in the population of Colusa County, 1,116 is to be credited to the towns of Albuque, Colusa City, Colusa, Orland, Williams and Willows. Thus the rural population of Colusa County increased only 406; but when the natural increase of the original population or that found in the county in 1880 is considered, it lost over 1,000.

The same showing as to Tehama County will be instructive. The aggregate of the one hundred largest holdings increased nearly 500,000 acres between 1880 and 1890. The population of the county in 1880 was 9,301; in 1890 it was 9,916, being an apparent gain of 615. More than this entire gain is attributable to the two towns of Red Bluff and Vina, so that there was absolutely no increase in the rural population of that county, but a decrease. The natural increase of a population of 9,301 would be 180. The county therefore lost 1,245, notwithstanding the apparent gain of 615. In two townships of that county alone, there was an actual loss of population, not considering the natural gain or the natural increase of population there, of 1,790 people. Here are two rural townships in a single county losing nearly two thousand people by actual count, to which, of course, must be added the loss of natural increase of their population in ten years. Recalling the fact that the one hundred largest holders had added 500,000 acres to their holdings, or an average of 5,000 acres each, and the effect of the aggregation of large land-holdings in the State of California becomes unmistakable.

The increase of population in Solano County confirms this conclusion. If the reader will now recur to the tabulated statements above he will perceive that the aggregated large land-holdings of the county have been moving on a horizontal plane for ten years. The population of Solano County in 1880 was 18,475, and in 1890 it was 20,946, being an apparent gain of 2,471. Of this gain six incorporated towns in the county are credited with 1,445, leaving an increase of 1,026 in the rural population in ten years in that county. As soon, therefore, as the aggregation of large land-holdings is arrested, the population shows a gain. We do not wish to be understood as saying that the gain of population in Solano County was satisfactory, because this was not the case; the gain of population in that county should have been 3,685, and if the large holdings had been broken up and the land had been distributed to cultivators, instead of held by monopolists, this increase would have been achieved.
