

THE THORNY PATH.

Office Holding, and Its Pitfalls That Endanger Young Men.

Sam Seabough's Warning to a Youthful Friend Many Years Ago—The Road to Intemperance.

"Public office-holding didn't do that young man any good," remarked a business man to a friend the other day, as an ex-public official passed up J street with a flushed face and suspicious unsteadiness about his legs.

"I tell you," resumed the merchant, as a Record-Union reporter came along, "that about the worst thing a young man can do is to go scrambling about to get into office. That young man hardly knew what it was to taste liquor until he allowed himself to be talked into becoming a candidate for an appointive office, and now he's full most of the time—that is, he generally has about about all the liquor he can carry. He has acquired habits he will not be able to shake off nearly so easy as he was shaken out of office."

"Which reminds me," said the other, "of a bit of advice I once received from Sam Seabough, the old-time journalist. In looking over some old letters the other day I found one from Seabough. It was written October 24, 1868—twenty-three years ago—shortly after he came to Sacramento as editorial writer on the Union. I was then out of a position, but had a very good political pull, and was using it to get a clerkship in the Custom-house under General Miller, and in a letter to Seabough I mentioned what I regarded as my prospective good fortune—an easy position and fair salary."

"Now, every body who knew Seabough knew that he hated to write letters; in fact, he rarely wrote one, and when, a day or two after I had written, I received a reply from him, I appreciated it, because that he was in dead earnest and wrote with a purpose in view. I have the letter with me, and the Record-Union may print it if it will do you any good. It is vice to all young men. The letter reads: SACRAMENTO, October 24, 1868. My Dear Friend: I received yours of the 23d inst. You speak of a clerkship in office in expectancy, as if you could not get over the idea of taking it. I am sorry for this. Without knowing exactly what office you were talking of, I will bring you in no direct compensation in money for the inevitable habits of indolence (not to say dissipation, from which I believe you have far above the average of exemption) you will contract there; and when you leave you will be really far less qualified to earn a living at any regular business than now."

No young man at your age can afford such a waste of time for preparation for future action in life. I have noted a good many of my friends who have done this, and put themselves to much trouble in securing such appointments, and in no single instance has the office obtained failed to work them a serious inconvenience, if not a positive injury. I speak of this matter with a pretty full knowledge of what I am talking about. Colonel James informed me once, after he had been Collector for four years, that he never made an appointment which resulted in a benefit to the appointee, nor ever discharged an incumbent who did not afterward come and thank him sincerely for relieving him of a place that was far more in the nature of a curse than a blessing. He said they were all dissatisfied, save only those who could not do anything else, and had already, of course, run pretty far along the descending scale of life.

You will probably think it strange that I should take upon myself the duty of writing this way to you; and in truth, I should not trouble myself to do so if I did not like you, and think it worth while to warn you against yielding to persuasions which I am convinced you should resist as firmly as you would bad company or intemperance. As a general rule, all offices not held directly from and directly responsible to the people, are a curse to those who hold them. If you want to work at your business, and can't get employment in San Francisco, come right up here. This city is becoming an exceedingly lively, pleasant and beautiful place, and I am sure that you would better situate yourself with respect to those in part dependent upon your exertions, as well as with regard to yourself, alone, by coming up here than by accepting the best Custom-house office. WANTS AN INVESTIGATION.

Assemblyman Bruner Makes a Request of the District Attorney. The following communication has been submitted by Assemblyman Elwood Bruner to District Attorney Ryan: Hon. Frank D. Ryan, District Attorney, Sacramento, California. Sir: I address you as the District Attorney of Sacramento County, with a request that, at your earliest convenience, you will call the attention of the Grand Jury of this county to the charges made against me by the San Francisco Examiner, a paper published in the city of San Francisco, of malfeasance in office as a member of the Assembly of the State of California, and especially in reference to my action in regard to the bills known as "the bill" and "the act" to prevent frauds upon travelers."

The history of the second charge is doubtless familiar to you. A conspiracy was formed, the secret purpose of which was locked in their own breasts, but whose outward manifestation was an attempt to blacken my character in the eyes of the world. At the head of the conspiracy was a Judge, who, when a candidate before his party convention but a few years since for the office of Member of Congress, was driven from the convention by the charge openly made by a citizen of this county, that he had paid the Judge while a member of the Supreme Bench the sum of \$5,000 as a bribe for a decision in the citizen's favor, of a case then pending in the Supreme Court. The records show that the decision came all right.

The second became the foreman of an alleged Grand Jury at the solicitation of the Judge. This man's name is unpleasantly associated with the acquisition of title of a large amount of Indian Reservation Government land, while a member of Congress. He it was, too, who when his native county needed every son as a defender, fled, a traitor to his flag, and aided the arms of Mexico against his record of citizenship. The third, a broker, acquired his fortune followed by the sighs and tears of widows and orphans. He failed in business, settled with his creditors at twenty cents on the dollar, and within a few months purchased property worth several hundred thousand dollars.

The three were backed by a powerful metropolitan daily newspaper, whose pages are filled with advertisements of places where the trail can be found, and whose blackmailing propensities are quite familiar to the courts and the public. Not content with "speaking" the above-named Grand Jury, they proceeded to aid and pack a trial jury for the avowed purpose of securing a conviction in my favor. Under the above circumstances I was compelled to appeal to a higher court to prevent this vicious and ruthless invasion of my constitutional and statutory rights as a citizen. The result of that appeal is known to you. The action of the San Francisco Grand Jury, conceived in malice and political hatred, has been arrested.

But I now desire a vindication, knowing that my political life has been clean, and that I am a citizen. My constituents, my family and myself, and to that end I lay bare my official life and desire that it be probed to the bottom. I will stand not in every way possible in this investigation.
