

YOUNG MEN CHRISTIANS. What They Are Doing for the Rising Generation.

The New Reception, Reading and Gymnasium—Rooms—Open House on New Year's Day.

The Young Men's Christian Association has been in existence in this city for some years, and, like many other organizations, it has had a varied experience. Sometimes those in charge have felt that it was almost impossible to accomplish what was intended, and that, perhaps, it would be as well to give up. But, in spite of the many discouragements and adversities that the organization has labored under, more and more work was done that is now bearing fruit.

For some time past the association has been growing in popularity, and its membership has rapidly increased. The State Convention, held here in October, gave to the general public a clearer idea of the work, and brought to their notice much that before had passed unobserved. The present management have taken the position that the rooms of the association should be one of the most attractive places of resort in the city, and that they are made so young men will show their appreciation of them. That this is the correct idea, is already factually demonstrated to those having the management in charge, and one only needs to drop in of an evening to see how well the rooms are patronized.

In November a competent Physical Director was secured, the gymnasium renovated and new apparatus put in. This is now a veritable hall of health, the association's idea being body building, rather than the training of athletes. Ten classes in physical culture are organized, meeting each week, and the gymnasium is kept open on Monday, Wednesday, Thursday and Saturday afternoons, and one Saturday morning. Beside this, individuals may be taken into the gymnasium at any hour during the day—some under medical advice, and others to develop some weak part of the body.

Not only has the night department received attention, but the reading matter has received many additions, so that now all the leading magazines and illustrated and scientific papers are found on the shelves, together with a number of daily papers. It has been found necessary to rearrange the rooms, so as to make the reading-room more comfortable for those who wish to read, and to provide an office and reception-room.

This work has been undertaken by the Women's Auxiliary, through whose interest and untiring efforts the rooms have been furnished, and the social work of the association kept up.

The changes that have been made have added very much to the attractiveness of the rooms, and now, instead of entering through a cheerless hallway, one steps from the street into a bright, airy reception-room and office, from which a view can be obtained of the parlor, reading-room and gymnasium. A small portion of the reading matter has been selected to get the space needed, but that is more than made up in comfort for those who use the reading-room, as they will not have to be disturbed by the conversation of the office, nor annoyed by the members passing through into the gymnasium.

The repairs are about completed, and on New Year's Day (to-morrow) the rooms will be ready for use. The association will keep open house on that day, and the men of the city, young or old, are cordially invited to call. The Women's Auxiliary, assisted by a number of young ladies, will receive the visitors. Refreshments, music, and social companionship will be the order of the day from 12 to 6 o'clock.

It is hoped that many of our citizens who have never visited the association rooms will do so at this time, and that an invitation is extended to the business men and others who so generously contributed to the support of the work, that they may see something of what is being done. At 8 o'clock a musical, literary and gymnastic entertainment will be given, for which a fine programme has been arranged.

One of the features of the evening will be a gymnastic exhibition, participated in by one of the finest young men of a class from the junior department. An admission fee of twenty-five cents will be charged for the evening entertainment, which will go to the auxiliary furnishing fund.

The association rooms are a boon to the young men. They are open every day in the year. They are clean, bright, and great, the privileges so many, and the membership fee so small, that it is really a very profitable investment from a money standpoint. It is one that every young man ought to be, and undoubtedly will be, double what it now is in six months' time.

BASEBALL GOSSIP.

McCloskey Likely to Manage Some "Texas Steers" Again. The baseball manager will meet in San Francisco to-day, when it may be determined whether or not Sacramento will be "in it" next year.

From all appearances, remarks the San Francisco Post, there will be many disappointed fans, while professional ball players in California next year. It is almost certain that one and perhaps two of the present clubs will be left out of the circuit. Manager Harris has intimated that he will not return to the circuit, and Colonel Robinson's advertisement for Eastern talent indicates that he will bring out another batch of ball tossers. In Sacramento, the management would be willing to sign all his players of 1891 with the exception of George Hanley.

It is very probable that John J. McCloskey, who managed the late Sacramento club, will have charge of some team in the South next season. There is a general revival of interest in the southern part of the country, and a number of minor leagues may be organized. Mr. McCloskey is well and favorably known throughout Texas and Louisiana, and would be readily tendered the management of one of the clubs should he express a desire to go back to his former quarters.

AMUSEMENTS.

Last Thursday the Record-Union gave an extended account of the musical exhibition of Master Henry W. Foster, the blind boy pianist, clarinetist and violinist. He came here from Oakland unknown and at an unpropitious time, and was not well announced to the public. As a result, the lad, who is poor and ambitious, had scarce two dozen people out to hear him. And was growing more and more discouraged, it being his first concert. But that small number were treated to a surprise. Friends and lovers of genius have interested themselves in the lad, and the institute consented to act as musical director, and A. C. Shaw will manage the affair. The price has been placed at 50 cents, and for children under 14, 25 cents. Master Henry, desiring all under his own age to have easy opportunity to hear him. The boy was born blind. At 7 he developed marvellous musical powers, and at 10 he was a wonder. He was taught the common branches as the blind are instructed at the Berkley Institute. But his musical ability far outstrips that of the institute system of music instruction, and

for three years past he has progressed by a memory system, his father reading to him, and he is imitating them on his memory and at once proceeding to their interpretation. His execution is brilliant and at times marvellously so. His ear is good and his feeling deep and strong, and as a result, he plays as if by inspiration, from classical writers or the simplest melodies of the hour. He is nervously eager to advance, but his affliction and lack of means hinder him; but the latter, it is believed, will not be for long—such talent as his must find a generous patron to aid it to its fullest possibilities. As mere curiosities, even if one cares little for good music, the illustration of this boy's powers will repay for attendance upon his concert, for nature appears to have endowed him with wonderful musical capacity in compensation for deprivation of sight and given him powers not one lad in a million possesses.

BALLOON JUMPING.

How it Feels to Drop Several Thousand Feet.

Hagal, the aeronaut, who lately made several ascensions here, in an interview with a San Jose Mercury reporter, thus describes the sensation of a parachute descent from the clouds: "The thing is all so simple to me that I can't understand why it should excite people as it does, for I have seen women faint away and men turn pale after I had cut the rope and started heavenward. Where are we? Oh, yes, going up, or rather the earth is dropping away from me, you know. That is the sensation. The double parachute, which I am to cut loose at the proper time, hangs listlessly downward. The rope which holds it to the balloon passes through a steel ring. A sharp knife-blade worked by a cord is so arranged that at the proper time a little jerk, and I am free from the balloon.

"Now comes the exciting moment. Above you the balloon, freed of the weight which gave it steadiness, is rocking and reeling, while the parachute is dropping downward. You are fully aware that you are descending, that you are going with such frightful velocity, too, that unless there comes an end soon, the end of your things will be in hand. "Suddenly the mad rush is checked. The parachute has grasped the situation, so to speak; at least, it has grasped it, and is now opening its arms. It gradually expands the motion becomes steadier, until you are descending so slowly and gently, and after the thrill of the descent of the moment before the feeling is so dreamily delicious that really you are in danger from it unless you brace up and fight it off, for mother earth is showing her fangs, and you are being jerked as you again.

"It really appears as if the earth came back to you, just as it seemed to recede, and you are looking out for a safe landing place and that more agility is required in this part of the feat than in any other."
