AFRICAN SUNS. And showers, adds greatly to its charm. Nothing of the kind has been seen since Rome itself has given me more pleasure.


ON A HILL. Behind, surrounded by a sort of cloister (some of the pillars are still erect), is the Temple of Jupiter, the only one in the city.


