SAN FRANCISCO, January 30th. The wheat market opened lower and weaker on call to-day on the strength of the Eastern advices, which indicated a downward turn in prices after an advance in the early morning of 1/4 cent. The transactions on call amounted to 800 tons of wheat, 700 May at \$1.32 1/2 @ 32 1/2, and 1400 of January at \$1.28. There was no barley sold.
