TWELFTH-STREET TRESTLE.

The Piles Being Driven and Grading Work Well Along.

The City's Plans Much More Solid and Durable Than Those of the County.

The work of building the Twelfth-street trestle for the city has commenced and the piles are being driven rapidly.

The trestle is the one which crosses the old bed of the American River, beginning at the foot of the railroad embankment on B street and replacing the old one at that point.

R. Silva, who has the contract for filling in the grade beyond the trestle, is well along with his work, being ahead of the trestle contractors.

The majority of the bids for the county trestle ranged from \$185,000 per foot, and when the contract was awarded it was freely stated by other contractors that the amount of the bid would not much more than cover the cost of the lumber.

On October 17th Mr. Layden appeared before the Supervisors with a proposition to construct the county's trestle on the same plan and specifications as the city's trestle at the same price the city pays.

When the bids for building the city's trestle were opened in the Board of Trustees there were two bids from San Francisco firms, one of whom secured the contract.
