Business Not Very Active in Market Circles at the Bay.

The Week in Local Circles Closes on a Fairly Good Market—Wild Game Plentiful.

SAN FRANCISCO, November 19th. In some respects the local produce market yesterday was slightly improved as compared with the preceding day, but this fact may be partially accounted for by the fact that the closing day of the week. Sales are usually better on Friday by reason of retailers stocking up for Saturday, but as Friday last was exceptionally dull, the increased demand was probably reserved until yesterday morning. Receipts were not above the average, but the varieties were fairly well distributed. All descriptions of Fresh Fruits were dull yesterday, and dealers complained considerably of the inactivity which necessitated the carrying over of heavy stocks. Choice red Apples are meeting with the inquiry, but all other varieties of which, by the way, there is a great abundance, are selling slowly, and asking prices are being liberally shaded. Pears and Figs fail to attract customers, and sales are slow. Strawberries are moving off fairly well at steady rates. Quinces are selling rather slowly. The supply of Grapes is greatly in excess of demand, and prices are not only very low, but dry. Dried Fruits are in heavy supply, and the demand remains rather limited. Creamery Butter is held firmly at the recent advance. Other grades are unchanged. Ranch Eggs are very weak, and sales are slow. Poultry is dull. Turkeys being plentiful and cheaper. The local wheat market is depressed, and transactions generally are of a large volume.

THE CAPITAL CITY. It is Rapidly Coming to the Front in Every Way. A. Burrows of Grass Valley, writing from Sacramento to the Tidings of that city, says: "The changes being made in Sacramento are so radical that before the next meeting of the Legislature there will be a brand new town. The old streets and sidewalks for miles have been torn up and asphaltum and concrete laid in place of cobble and boards. All the old awnings have been done away with by an ordinance, and light airy projections have taken their place. When the improvements are completed the city will not be a whit behind San Jose. There is no question of better public roads. It has been agitated, the brilliant editor of the RECORD-UNION and the bicycle clubs leading this march of progress. County bonds will probably be issued for this purpose. It is only a matter of time till the good roads movement reaches Nevada County, and at which everyone having one spark of the spirit of progress will rejoice.

THE FOLSOM CANAL. Practical Completion of the State's Portion of It. Referring to the work on the great canal and water power at Folsom the Telegraph says: "The State's work on the canal is nearing completion. A gang of men are already at work on the western end of the ditch, and at the rate the prison officials are now pushing the work, its completion, so far as they are concerned, can be but a matter of a few days. "During a recent visit to the dam we were forcibly impressed with the necessity of early action on the part of our citizens that Folsom may derive the advantages to which her situation on the canal will entitle her. Folsom will be the first town in a position to say to great manufacturing corporations: 'We can offer for your use the greatest developed water power on earth.' As that offer will be in our power but a short time, it certainly behooves us, as a business community, to be ready to take advantage of the opportunities which most decidedly will be in our favor. "The history of every successful city in the West is that they are the work of a united people who did their work through a vigorous, progressive Board of Trade, who found business men and site owners ready to strengthen their hands. "We believe the time has come when Folsom should have a Board of Trade, properly equipped to place in the hands of manufacturers and capitalists the advantages we have to offer, and which are all unknown outside a circumscribed limit.
