The Wheat Situation at San Francisco Very Dull.

Most Weather Causes a Softening in Barley Prices—Better Demand for Vegetables.

SAN FRANCISCO, May 14th. The wheat situation could hardly be more dull than it is at the present time. To-day is a holiday in England and no quotations came from that center. Shipping wheat in local circles is nominally worth 87 1/2c per cwt, there being no demand. Milling grades are lower, being quotable at 81 1/2c per cwt.

The demand for poultry is light and prices are weak. The vegetable market opened for the week with a better demand. Asparagus cleared up a little better. Onions and new potatoes are weak.


