Wheat Firm and Advanced, With Little Offering. Feed Barley Scarce—Very Light Receipts of Oats—Demand Fair at Unchanged Quotations.

SAN FRANCISCO, Jan. 8th. Wheat is firm and advanced; not much in to-day. Barley offerings are light and prices are as previously quoted; choice bright feed is particularly scarce.

Potatoes and Onions are firm for choice stock. Green Peas are cheaper and take a wide range as to quality. A few Mushrooms in, but not enough to quote.


