Arrested. Since the establishment of the drug department at the "C. C. C.," and the dispensing of medicines at fair profits, the old "extortionates" in the business have taken great umbrage at the prices. Through their influence some of the wholesale druggists have refused to sell the City and Country Co-operative drug supplies. Notwithstanding these impediments, the business of the "C. C. C." has continued to grow rapidly. To-day the spite broke out in public form by the arrest of the manager upon a warrant sworn out by the Secretary of the State Board of Pharmacy. The case was set for trial in Judge Davis' court on next Tuesday. They intend to still continue to sell at the same prices until they are compelled by law to desist—not only drugs but everything in their line.

The Report of the State Board of Agriculture for 1895.

The annual report of the State Board of Agriculture for the year 1895 has been issued from the State Printing Office. It was compiled by Secretary Edwin F. Smith, and is a very interesting and valuable volume. It contains various laws in force relating to the State and District Associations; a complete report of the transactions of the former for the year 1895, with a comprehensive and impartial review of the condition of the various branches of agriculture, horticulture, dairying, etc.; an article from Director J. A. Barwick of the State Weather Bureau, with valuable statistics of the meteorology of the State; tabulated statements of the receipts and expenditures of the society during the year; list of premiums awarded; special articles on important topics written by prominent persons and officials; exports of grain and fruits.

Indeed, the report covers a very wide range of topics, and would be a very valuable aid to immigration if it could have general distribution among the people east of the Rocky Mountains. The association and Secretary Smith, its very efficient and experienced Secretary, have reason to be proud of this truly valuable publication.
