

That way out is as follows: Order to coinage all the silver bullion gained by seigniorage, and the property of the United States, and in its Treasury. At the same time make all our silver coinage legal tender to the extent of \$50. Issue a silver note of \$20 for convenience of handling, but provide that no gold shall be coined or any issue of paper made based on gold under the denomination of \$20.
