Contractors Realize That the People Are Above Them.

The Conviction of Street Sprinkler Rosas Has Had a Salutory Effect.

Here are some important lessons drawn from actual facts, which will be of first-class value to our people, to the City Trustees and to the Superintendent of Street Sprinkling.

They will be of high value also next spring when the Trustees come to the awarding of contracts for the sprinkling of the streets of the city.

First—Sprinkling Contractor Rosas was arrested on Thursday last for flooding N street—not by official action but by the City Trustees.

Second—Since the arrest and conviction of Rosas there has been remarkable reform all over the city in the method of street sprinkling.

Another ice wagon proprietor was stopped and asked what was the matter with the wheels of his vehicle.

Over fifty cyclists were stopped and asked if they had noted the change, and all replied, with enthusiasm, in the affirmative.

Yesterday was a delightful driving day, the streets were free from mud, in most part, and for the first time in months there was no complaint because of sprinkling.
