

COMMERCIAL. FLOUR DROPS IN SYMPATHY WITH WHEAT. Tendency of the Wheat Market Weak-Barley Fairly Steady -Oats Quiet.

San Francisco, Oct. 26th. In sympathy with the recent decline in wheat there has been a drop of 50c per barrel in flour. Shipments Saturday were 4,800 barrels to Australia, 1,000 to Honolulu, 1,000 to the market, and 1,000 to other ports.

Barley is fairly steady. There is not a great deal of offering, but still more than enough for the few days. Options are quiet and easy, both December and May being lower.

There is very little demand for rye and not much showing for an extra choice lot. It is asked, but no business is doing. A shipment of 3,000 casks to Antwerp on Saturday.
