WHEAT STILL RISING AND VALUES HIGHER.

Feed Barley Firm and Scarce—Butter Market Weak—Eggs Easier.

San Francisco, Nov. 4th. The rising wheat market has strengthened flour, and an advance of 25c per barrel is noted.

Wheat is still rising and both spot and speculative values are higher. May wheat this morning showed an advance of 1c on Monday's best price.

Some fancy butter brings more than top quotations, but the general feeling is weak. Eggs are moving slowly, and while quotations are not actually lower, the tone of the market is easier.
