Santa Ana Blade: There will not be any more elections, thank God, for nearly two years, and the man who stops his paper because it don't support "his candidate" or agree with him on all points will have nearly two years in which to renew his subscription and forget all about his grievance.

Los Angeles Herald: Greece is living up to her glorious traditions and is willing to sacrifice herself in a desperate effort for the cause of right. The "insurgents" are concentrating their forces at Artas on the west coast, which is but twenty-four hours' journey from Athens. The three divisions of the Turkish army are stationed at Salonica, Ellassona and Janina in Macedonia. The last-named city, according to the treaty of Berlin, rightfully belongs to Greece, and the "insurgents" are planning its capture. The first naval engagement will in all probability be off Salonica. In the meantime the Powers are inclining to a move granting the Cretans autonomy with power to choose their own Governor. This is precisely what Greece and Greece have been asking for all along, but the move has been so desperately slow that in all probability it will now be too late to avert war.

WHEAT METHODS. Tulare Register: Sometimes the consequences of our own good deeds are scarcely less hard to bear than are the consequences of our deeds which are evil. For instance, California has revolutionized the wheat growing methods of the world. Her people invented headers, combined harvesters, perfected the gang plow and made wheat growing immensely profitable in countries that have since competed with California in the production of wheat almost to the destruction of the industry and the impoverishment of those engaged in it. The world has been immensely the gainer, but the good our inventors did has been hard for California farmers to bear.

SAN FRANCISCO'S CARNIVAL. Santa Rosa Press: San Francisco has abandoned the Golden Gate carnival project, those having charge in charge giving as an excuse for that action the lack of subscriptions. Many never seriously believed that San Francisco would carry out its grand carnival scheme. It was conceived in a glamor and grandeur that usually extends all its force in talk. The metropolitan city is going to give up the idea before it was attempted in the floral line. It was to be a carnival that would make all other carnivals crowded into one appear insignificant in comparison therewith. It looked easy on paper, and the promoters made a wonderful success of it in their own minds in the actual work; then they realized the magnitude of the task before them, and they soon quit. Had they been equipped with the experience many others have had they would have appreciated the undertaking before them. They would have known that to give a floral festival in a city as large as San Francisco, that would be as much a credit to it as the carnivals were a credit to the smaller towns, would be almost an impossibility. Some of the most beautiful features of Santa Rosa's carnivals were the store decorations, and many came from miles just to see them. But all the flowers in a county would make but little show in the decoration of stores of a great city, and it was no doubt wise on the part of San Francisco to abandon the scheme.

EASTERN TRADE OUTLOOK. Marysville Appeal: In its general aspect, the condition of trade exhibits hopeful features. At the moment there is a check to operations from the uncertainty about the prices of wide ranges of goods, growing out of the impending changes of tariff. The extraordinary floods in the Mississippi Valley have also an interrupting effect,

not only from the direct loss of property, but from the suffering, but also from the suspension of transport facilities over a large expanse of country. Also, some misgivings are felt as to the possibility of cotton planting being delayed in certain flooded sections. In spite of these drawbacks, the feeling in trade circles is reasonably sanguine, all things considered. Although purchases are upon a moderate scale, yet they are frequent and the aggregate is not discouraging, either as to amount or profits. The quarterly reports of the commercial agencies show a remarkably small amount of liabilities in the three months' figures, which is a gratifying indication of the financial condition of men of business and helps to stiffen confidence in mercantile credits.

SCARED INTO SOCIALISM. San Jose Mercury: The announcement that Mrs. Mary E. Lease has abandoned Populism and adopted Socialism is not in itself a remarkable piece of news, nor is the fact particularly interesting. Mrs. Lease is but a type of a numerous class of persons who have entered into an investigation of present social conditions, and after probing around in the depths for a time announce that social and economic conditions are "all wrong," are founded on a false basis and the utter destruction of society itself will result if we keep on in maintaining them. They point as proof that their conclusions are correct to the great centralizing of capital, the destruction of competition by combines and trusts, the crowding out of small tradesmen and small manufacturers and the monopolization of the natural resources of the country by a few who control the existence of the rest of the people.

After reaching the conclusion that society must be reformed these self-styled sociologists declare that the adoption of the principles of socialism is the only adequate means of reformation; that the State should assume control of all production and distribution and all the people to become mere employees of the State.

The jumping at such a conclusion shows the superficiality of their investigations and the narrowness of their reasoning. They overlook the most important forces now operating upon society and fail to take into account the power of this factor in securing reforms of social conditions. We refer to the progress on science and invention which every day is giving forth new ideas, new processes, new machines wherewith man may more readily wield the forces of nature, and secure them as means of subsistence. In the domain of science and invention the tendency is from the complex to more simple forms, whether it be in machines or in formulae. Science can knock out a trust quicker than an Act of Congress. An airship would end transportation monopoly, a new process of extracting sugar would destroy the sugar trust, a cheap substitute for cattle hides would dissolve the leather trust quicker than would an injunction from a Federal Court. As these new inventions become more simple and inexpensive so much more would they be in the hands of individual producers. In other words, the individual would have it in his power to compete with the trusts. The only monopoly to provide against is that which would seek to monopolize the forces of nature.

NOT A LOCAL ISSUE. Los Angeles Times: There is much more reason for a duty of 1 per cent. per pound on oranges and lemons than for a duty of 1 cent per pound on grapes and peaches. The grower of grapes is to some considerable extent protected by the perishable nature of his product. The same, to a less degree, is true of grapes. But citrus fruits can be kept for a long time after being picked from the trees, and can be shipped long distances without danger of serious deterioration. For this reason, no protection in the form of a duty can be shipped into the United States, to the great detriment of domestic industry.

Those Eastern Senators and Representatives who are joining hands with the New York importers against the products of California are exhibiting a very narrow and petty spirit. Protection is not a "local issue," the lamented General Hancock to the contrary notwithstanding. It is the broadest kind of a national issue, and should be treated as such. The great staple products of each and every section of the country are entitled, by the verdict of the people as rendered at the late national election, to ample protection. That verdict was not rendered in favor of any particular locality, nor was the result achieved by the voters of any one section. As the result of the election was general, so should the legislation which follows it be general in character. No one locality should be favored at the expense of another locality. Having secured protection for their products, the Eastern Senators and Representatives should be willing in all fairness to grant as full protection to the products of the West.

If importers and foreign Governments are to allow us to dictate the terms of our tariff laws there will be no particular reason why the American people should vote on the tariff question at all. It would save a great deal of trouble, time and expense to turn the whole matter over to the free-trade attorneys, the importers, and the representatives of European Governments in the United States. Our Congress, being thus relieved of the burdens and responsibilities of legislation, might turn its attention to plans and specifications for relieving the condition of the destitute savages of Patagonia, or to some other equally beneficent work of charity.

HARSH CRITICISM. Los Angeles Express: Friday's issue of the San Francisco newspapers contains the information that the proposed Carnival of the Golden Gate has been abandoned. A meeting of the committee was held, at which a final report of the financial managers was rendered to the effect that only \$14,000 had been raised out of the \$25,000 that was considered necessary to make the affair a success, and that there was no hope of raising much more in the short time remaining before the date set.

The whole performance relative to this affair has been entirely characteristic of San Francisco, that this outcome forms a fitting conclusion, and rounds out what might have been expected in that city.

The time was when San Francisco was an active, progressive, public-spirited city. It had a reputation for its hospitality, and was wont to do its share and more in all things that were for the good of the State. Those were the days when the mines of this State and Nevada and Arizona were pouring their wealth into the lap of the Golden Gate. When money was free, and giving involved no special sacrifice. But those days are gone. There is still plenty of wealth in San Francisco, but it is in the hands of men who are almost devoid of patriotic sentiment for the city in which they live. That the merchants should be disposed to close their eyes to what appears to be not so strange, as business has been very bad in San

Francisco for a number of years, and if the property owners, whose interests are directly at stake in the advancement of the city refuse to do their share, it is scarcely to be expected that the tenant who pays a high rent and then scarcely gets expenses out of his business should do very much.

GOSPEL WAGON. New and Effective Method of Spreading the Gospel Light.

A new enterprise in evangelistic work has been inaugurated under the leadership of Rev. H. E. Adams of the Baptist denomination. Equipped with suitable wagons loaded with Bibles, tracts, illustrated papers, etc., a band of devoted men and women go into the mountain regions, holding religious services, visiting homes and carrying the gospel to people who in many instances have not heard the Word of God for twenty years.

This gospel wagon enterprise is now in this neighborhood and will hold a service at Calvary Baptist Church on Sunday evening, when they will tell the thrilling story of their work.
