

SYLLABUS. (S. F., No. 687—Department Two—Filed June 18, 1897.) Elizabeth A. Heydenfeldt, petitioner; Sullivan Court, V. Coffey, Judge, respondent. Review. Writ denied.

(S. F., No. 506—Department Two—Filed June 18, 1897.) Eli R. Chase, appellant; George A. Putnam, Action in claim and delivery. Reversed.

The sale of any property on which there is a lien in satisfaction of the claim secured thereby, or in case of personal property, its wrongful conversion by the person holding the lien, extinguishes the lien thereof. C. C. Sec. 2017. No deed with the requirements of the law and by failure to do so his sale is void, and he thereafter claims title under such void sale, he must be deemed to have waived or lost his lien.
