SACRAMENTO'S SHIPMENTS.

SHE LED ALL THE CITIES THE LAST MONTH. Exclusive of Fruit Shipments, Her Eastern Freights Were Immense.

Sacramento leads all other cities in the State in the way of freight shipments to Eastern points during the last month, not even excepting San Francisco.

The metropolis shipped 16,383 tons, while Sacramento's output was 18,169 tons. Oakland shipped 1,636 tons, San Jose 1,226, Stockton 6,286 and Marysville 3,325.

Of course the greater part of Sacramento's freight output consists of fruit, of which there were 11,946 tons, but the same can be said of Stockton, Oakland, San Jose and Marysville, all of which cities are in fruit centers.

Outside her fruit shipments, however, Sacramento shipped within a few tons of as much freight as Stockton, with her 3,262 tons of fruit, and more than five times as much as San Jose, with her fruit included. The shipments were as follows:

ORDINANCE NO. 348. An Ordinance Amending Section Six of Ordinance Number Three Hundred and Twelve, Relating to the Condemnation, Construction, Alteration and Repairs of Sidewalks, Bulkrheads and Curbing, passed June 28, 1894.

THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE City of Sacramento do ordain as follows: Section 1. Section six of Ordinance Number Three Hundred and Twelve, City of Sacramento, passed April 3, 1883, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 1. Section two of an ordinance entitled, "Regulating the Use of Sidewalks in the City of Sacramento," passed June twenty-third, eighteen hundred and ninety-four, is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage.

ORDINANCE NO. 351. Establishing a Market Place for Hay, Straw, Grain, Wood Coal, Coke and Charcoal on the Public Square Bounded by B. C. Fifteenth and Sixteenth Streets, and Fixing a Penalty for Making Sales of Any Such Materials at Any Other Place in the City.

Section 1. The public square, bounded by B. C. Fifteenth and Sixteenth streets, is hereby designated and set apart as a market place, free of rent charges, for hay, straw, grain, wood, coal, coke and charcoal, at which place any person, firm, or corporation, who stand wagon, carts and other vehicles carrying such material, and who solicit customers therefor, and from said square deliver any such material, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof, shall be punished by a fine not exceeding fifty dollars, or by imprisonment in the County Jail for a period of time equivalent to one day for each two dollars of the fine imposed, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

Section 2. Any person found guilty of violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and shall be punished by a fine not less than ten dollars, nor more than one hundred dollars, or by imprisonment in the County Jail for a period of time equivalent to one day for each two dollars of the fine imposed, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

Section 3. Any person found guilty of violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and shall be punished by a fine not less than ten dollars, nor more than one hundred dollars, or by imprisonment in the County Jail for a period of time equivalent to one day for each two dollars of the fine imposed, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

Section 4. All other ordinances heretofore in force and effect in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage.
