

ATTENDANCE INCREASING. Close of the First Week of the Fair.

By arrangement between the State Agricultural Society and the merchants and business men generally of the city, Thursday next has been set apart as Sacramento Day at the State Fair.

In spite of the fact that the Pavilion is well worth seeing, and that every display is now in good order, the crowds yesterday afternoon and last night were not what they should have been.

There is an interesting display of amateur talent among the hangings, especially seen in many of the still-life themes that abound in the Oakland group.

One of the strongest and most impressive of the professional exhibits is "Cattle" (243), by William Hahn, deceased, formerly a well-known San Francisco painter.

For the Capital City Handicap, one and an eighth miles, the line-up was: Marplot 8 to 5, Scarborough 2 to 1, Buckwa 3 to 5, Grady 6 to 1.

This was a horse race from start to finish, although the time made was slow, 1:56. Marplot led by the stand in the end-off, with Scarborough, Buckwa and Grady all in a bunch.
