

SERVICES OF MISS AUSTIN.

DEFENSE OFFERS TO PROVE THEIR VALUE.

Judge Ellison Refuses to Permit Testimony by Experts on That Point.

The third week of the Austin-Wilcoxson case was resumed before Judge Ellison yesterday morning.

Miss Kate Plunkett of San Francisco, who maintains a first-ment bureau for women, was the first witness called.

She testified that she knew the serviceable value of a companion in this State. The question as to the intrinsic value of such services was met with an objection from plaintiff's attorneys.

Attorney Fulweller for the plaintiff contended that H. W. Johnson had objected to testimony offered on the ground that there could be no expert testimony upon the matter.

Attorney H. W. Johnson contended that he had all along held the position that the plaintiff could only recover for the actual intrinsic value of her services.

Attorney Grove L. Johnson said the exigencies of the case for the defense made it necessary for them to blow hot and cold at the same time.

At Judge Ellison's suggestion the witness was withdrawn until the afternoon session, at which time he would, he said, decide the point raised.

The defense offered in evidence the deposition of Estell L. Gray, taken in Yolo County, in May, 1898.

Attorney Grove L. Johnson objected to the introduction of the deposition, not being given plaintiff that it was to be taken.
