Election Proclamation.

EXECUTIVE DEPARTMENT, TERRITORY OF ARIZONA, OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR.

To All Persons Whom it May Concern, Greeting.

WHEREAS Under an act of the Legislative Assembly of the Territory of Arizona, entitled "Elections" approved February 12, 1888, and amended by the Legislature of the Territory of Arizona, approved November 4, 1888, and every two years thereafter, the members of the Legislative Assembly and such officers as may be required by law to be chosen at such elections; and

WHEREAS It is further provided in such act "That at least thirty days before the general election, the Governor must issue an election proclamation, designating the time of the election and the officers to be elected."

Now, therefore, I, C. Meyer Zwick, Governor of the Territory of Arizona, in pursuance of the duty enjoined upon me do hereby order a general election to be held upon the TUESDAY AFTER THE FIRST MONDAY IN NOVEMBER, A. D. 1888, and designate the officers to be elected as follows, to-wit:

One Delegate to Fifty-first Congress of the United States, twelve in number to the Council of the Legislative Assembly of the Territory, and twenty-two members of the House of Representatives of the Territory, as follows: County of Apache one member of the council and two members of the house of representatives; Cochise county one member of the council and five members of the house of representatives; Graham county one member of the council and two members of the house of representatives; Maricopa county one member of the council and five members of the house of representatives; Pima county one member of the council and five members of the house of representatives; Yuma county one member of the council and five members of the house of representatives; and

County of Yavapai shall elect one member of the council jointly with the counties of Apache, Graham, Maricopa, and the county of Cochise shall elect one member of the council jointly with the counties of Graham, Pima, and Yuma counties, and the county of Pinal shall elect one member of the council and one member of the house of representatives; and
