FLAME SWEEP

A Destructive Fire Raging in the Popular Residence Portion of Columbus, Ga.

It Looks Like a Fight-The Militia Ordered out and Fitzsimmons Under Arrest-The Porte Warned.

COLUMBIA, Ga. Oct. 30.-A fire is raging in one of the most popular residence districts of Columbus, and beyond the control of the fire department. Five handsome residences and the girls high school building are burned. The fire is fanned by a strong wind, which carries live coals for blocks. It looks as if a territory will be burned over. Stores are closed and the clerks are fighting the fire.

SAN FRANCISCO, Oct. 30.-District Attorney Barnes today began the closing argument on behalf of the state in the Durrant case. The court room was crowded to its greatest capacity, and close attention was paid to the speaker. Judge Murphy will charge the jury tomorrow morning and a verdict is expected tomorrow night.

LITTLE ROCK, Ark. Oct. 30.-Fitzsimmons was met at Marshall, Texas, by Sheriff Haupt and left at once for Silverport. A warrant was issued for the arrest of Sheriff Haupt, of Garland county, who is engaged in an effort to get Fitzsimmons to Hot Springs. The sheriffs of Clarke, Lafayette and Ouachita Counties were notified of the arrest of Fitzsimmons and Julian, and to hold them for the sheriff of Pulaski county. As the party are on a special train, it is improbable they will be arrested.

John L. Sullivan has been engaged by a New York newspaper to report the Corbett-Fitzsimmons fight.

HOT SPRINGS, Ark. Oct. 30.-An announcement from Little Rock says that Gov. Clarke has placed the state militia under waiting orders, produced no perceptible effect upon the local sporting fraternity.

LITTLE ROCK, Oct. 30.-Governor Clark has called out the First regiment to stop the fight between Corbett and Fitzsimmons. The companies of Paine, Buff, Helena, Cabot and Jacksonville have been ordered to be ready to march this afternoon.
